

CARDUUS

(HOMEOPATHIC)

CARDUUS contains liver tonic herbs for excellent liver support. CARDUUS is used for acute, subacute, or chronic diseases of the liver and gallbladder. The liver produces bile, which is stored and concentrated in the gallbladder. Bile is needed for the proper digestion of fats. Improper digestion may lead to symptomatic complaints. To resolve the dysfunction and support the liver and gallbladder, CARDUUS may be used. For diseases of the liver, such as those related to liver-heart-kidney syndrome, CARDUUS is beneficial by removing liver congestion, liver deficiency or with a constitutional indication. CARDUUS may be effective in: gallbladder conditions; constipation; stasis of the portal vein; hemorrhoids; hepatopathy with constipation and difficulty in fat digestion. It may also improve the bile secretion that helps to remove small gallstones (gravel); acts as an anti-spasmodic and stimulates the blood flow in the portal vein.

| Cascara sagrada | Constipation; cholecystitis. |
| Berberis vulgaris | Hepatic affections with various hemorrhoidal and menstrual complaints; liver dysfunction; cholelithiasis. |
| Carduus marianus | Liver and gall bladder pain; hepatic; cholagogue; demulcent; galactagogue; liver congestion; biliary colic and drainage agent. |
| Chelidonium majus | Gall colic; gallstones; hepatic; anti-inflammatory; cholagogue; bitter; anti-cholelithiasis. |
| Cuprum metallicum | Spasmodic affections; nausea. |
| Leptandra virginica | Depression; rectal hemorrhage; hepatic; cholagogue; laxative; diaphoretic; anti-spasmodic. |
| Magnesia phosphorica | Flatulent colic; cramps. |
| Myrica cerifera | Jaundice; bitter taste and nausea with offensive breath; astringent; circulatory stimulant; diaphoretic. |
| Natrium sulphuratum | Hepatitis stitching pains in the liver. |
| Taraxacum officinale | Bilious attacks; with characteristically mapped tongue and jaundiced skin; hepatic; cholagogue; diuretic; anti-rheumatic; laxative; tonic and bitter. |

SPECIAL COMMENTS

CARDUUS is primarily a gallbladder remedy with secondary effects on the liver. It can also regulate hepatic functions and very good results can be expected treating hepatopathies with constipation and stasis of the portal vein. A related formulation, HEPATICA, is primarily a liver remedy.
