OXYPLEX is recommended for the elimination of pathological flora in the gut. While not a purgative, it can cause loose stools. If diarrhea is severe, OXYPLEX therapy should be discontinued until symptom improves. OXYPLEX should not be used for longer than one week. OXYPLEX may be used as the first phase of a gut detoxification protocol to eliminate the pathological flora. However, OXYPLEX is not effective against mycoses (other agents should be considered). To enhance healing, it should be followed by CALMORA. PROBIOTIC 7-IN-1 should also be used to assist in re-establishing healthy intestinal flora.
